Prerequisites for admission to the PhD programme

Here: Allocation of unmarked credit points (ECTS)

Promotionsordnung §8(1) 4 (Doctoral Degree Regulations §8(1)4):

Proof of 10 credit points in the context of academical training. The Doctoral Committee decides about validation of these credit points.

Activities you can use:

- Participation at an academic conference with your own presentation (Poster or Presentation), documented by the conference programme (e.g. screenshot of programme and screenshot of the abstract of your presentation/poster)

for conferences lasting 1-2 days: **1 ECTS each**

for conferences lasting 3 days or longer: **2 ECTS each**

- Participation in Research Colloquia (own working group or others)
Own presentation and attendance of 10 others, no time constraints (presentations do not need to be in one semester)

Confirmation of attendance by the supervisor (use the document below).

1 ECTS for one presentation and attendance of 10 other presentation

- Visit to a lab/working group/research institute outside of Leipzig, with your own academic presentation,
confirmation of said presentation by hosting lab/working group/institute

1 ECTS per visit with presentation

- Attendance of Lectures/Modules (e.g. B.Sc. and M.Sc. studies) at a university, including some kind of contribution (presentation, exam, term paper). ECTS will be awarded following the course description.

At most 3 ECTS per PhD

- Attendance at academic training with your own contribution (e.g. teaching programme within a graduate programme, workshops, method and statistics courses, interdisciplinary qualification courses, summer schools, etc)

Your own contribution can be: practical exercises, writing code, statistical analysis in exercises and homework, presentations or exams, or similar contributions.

1 ECTS for 15 45min lectures (in person) and preparations/homework, totalling 25-30h workload
Max. 2 ECTS per training (15h trainings equal 1 ECTS, 30h trainings equal 2 ECTS)

Trainings shorter than 15h can be combined, so that each bundle of trainings equals 1 ECTS.

Proof of attendance via certificate, it is recommended to use the template given with this document.

- Academic award: **1 ECTS, once**

Activities need to include at least two of these categories.

The Doctoral Committee decides about validation of any further credit points.

These new regulations take effect on 8 April 2024. Upon request by the PhD candidate, until 31 December 2026, the old regulations can be applied instead.
